How to get to: O Grove by train / bus

From the airport: take a bus or a taxi to the bus station (estación de autobuses) or to the train station (estación de RENFE). From there you take the bus/train to „Pontevedra“. Get off in Pontevedra and take a bus to O Grove. (in Pontevedra the bus station is in front of the train station) The last bus departs at 22:00). There are also some buses which go directly from Vigo to O Grove. From the bus station O Grove to our meeting point Café “La Marquesina” it is just 5 minutes walk.

	<p>Journy by car</p> <p>Comming from Germany, Austria or Switzerland we recommend you come to spain via Irún or San Sebastián. From San Sebastián there a 2 possibilities. The time and the distance are almost the same. We recommend that you buy an up to date road map of Spain as a number of new motorways have been built recently.</p> <p>1)<i>along the northside:</i> The motorway (from Bilbao is free) is completed until Oviedo/Avilés. From Avilés you go towards La Coruña via Luarca, Navia and Ribadeo. Aproximately 10 km behind Ribadeo turn to the left side going to La Coruña (N-634). Schortly before arriving in Baamonde take the A6 (motorway is free) going to La Coruña. The slip road Santiago is signposed (N-634). The motorwayto Santiago and Pontevedra begins at Santiago airport</p> <p>. Aproximately 10 km before Pontevedra leave the motorway at Sanxenxo/O Grove and change to the expressway to O Grove.</p> <p>2)<i>Trough the inland:</i> Leave the motorway in San Sebastián (if it is very busy it is advisable to take the toll road until Burgos). Then take the N-1 igoino to Vitoria/Burgos. The motorway to Palencia/ Valladolid begins shortly before Burgos. At the slip road Palencia go on to Benavente. From Benavente some kilometres on the A-6 towards La Coruña an d than go on the A-52 to Ourense/Vigo. Curtly before Vigo the A-52 changes in to the A-9 (road charge) going to Pontevedra. In Pontevedra go on towards Santiago until you reach the slip road Sanxenxo/O Grove.</p> <p>Being in O Grove stay on the mainroad (always straight ahead) until you can see our meeting point on the left side,the Café 'La Marquesina' (ca. 50 m) .</p>
