How to get to: **O Grove** by train / bus


From the airport: take a bus or a taxi to the bus station (estación de autobuses) or to the train station (estación de RENFE). From there you take the bus/train to „Pontevedra“. Get off in Pontevedra and take a bus to O Grove. (in Pontevedra the bus station is in opposite of the train station) The last bus departs at 22:00). There are also some buses which go directly from Vigo to O Grove. It's just a 5 minute walk from the bus station in O Grove to our meeting point, Café „la Marquesina“.

Vigo – Pontevedra : approx. 2, 50 € takes approx. 30 minutes

Pontevedra – O Grove: approx 4,00 € takes approx. 1 hour

Vigo – O Grove: approx. 8,00 € takes approx: 90 minutes

If you are coming from Germany, Austria or Switzerland by car, we recommend you cross the border into Spain via Irún or San Sebastian. There are 2 possible routes from there, both take more or less the same time. You should buy an up to date road map of Spain as a number of new motorways have been finished recently.

- 1) The Coastal Road: Take the toll free road towards Bilbao and then as far as Oviedo / Avilès. From there you go towards La Coruña via Luarca, Navia and Ribadeo. About 10km from Ribadeo you turn to the left and take the N634 towards La Coruña. Just before you get to Baramonde change onto the toll-free A6 motorway, again towards La Coruña. There is a signposted slip road to Santiago and Pontevedra which begins at Santiago airport. About 10km before Pontevedra come off the motorway at Sanxenxo / O Grove and from there you drive on to O Grove.
- 2) The inland Route: Come off the motorway in San Sebastian. If the traffic is heavy we advise you to take the toll road as far as Burgos. There you take the N-1 towards Victoria / Burgos, Just before Burgos change onto the Palencia / Valladolid motorway, then go towards Benavente and from there The A6 towards La Coruña. From here you go on to the A-52 towards Ourense / Vigo. Shortly before Vigo change over on to the A9 towards Pontevedra and Santiago. After Pontevedra you will come to an exit signed Sanxenxo / O Grove. Take this road and when you get to O Grove stay on the main road towards town and you will find our meeting point ' Café la Marquesina' on the left hand side.
